


# His & Hers Pop-up Sale

Corrine and David have been creating in Ocean Shores for the past several years. She focuses on clothing made from old quilts and other "found" materials. He is a writer and colored pencil artist. Come check out what they have been making lately.

Corrine makes coats, jackets and vests out of primarily old cast-off quilts. She stumbled upon this art form when a friend offered her a couple of old worn out quilt tops. She entered several of them in this year's Wearable Art Show. She says the warmth of these garments is perfect for our chilly beach days year round. The jackets can be dressy or casual. The full length coats could be housecoats or worn by a bride to and from her wedding. The "Cozy" is a pullover style that can be worn on the beach or around the house to save on your heating bill. Come try them on and see how it feels to wear a quilt.

David has been writing most of his life. He has 3 collections of poetry, one of which includes the work of his son as well as an uncle. His prose includes a book of short stories and two longer tales based loosely on some of his life experiences. He also has been drawing for a lot of his life. He took up colored pencil drawing under the tutelage of Penny Dalton at the Gallery of Ocean Shores. He continues to work in this art form expressing much emotion in his rendition of everyday local scenes as well as from his travels.
