

Artist of the month for January - Beth Allos

Her art has been in ceramics,

<mark>jewelry, stained glass,</mark> mosaics and metal smithing. Presently, she does ceramic tiles in alcohol ink with a resin coating.



Beth will tell you that she loves color whether it's ocean blue, mermaid green or sunset orange. Alcohol ink is a perfect

medium for bright colors; and white tiles make the perfect canvas. Beth's inspiration is the surrounding beauty of the Pacific Northwest.

You can find Beth's art at Alder Grove Gallery in Aberdeen, Octopus Crafts in Ocean Shores, Annual Art Splash Studio Tour of Ocean Shores in August and various festivals throughout Grays Harbor.

The CIC and the Associated Arts of Ocean Shores (AAOS) have partnered to produce an art exhibit entitled "Winter on the Washington Coast" which is now on display at the Coastal Interpretive Center.

The CIC and AAOS sought out artwork depicting winter on the Washington Coast to display in the exhibit. All mediums of visual art were considered and artists were able to submit multiple works for consideration.

The art went on display at the Coastal Interpretive Center as of January 8th, 2022. We are so very pleased with the work itself and the number of entries that were received. It is a must see to get your art fix from our local and very talented artists. Entrants were encouraged to be Members of AAOS but it was open to the general public. There will be another offering from the CIC and AAOS later this year.

AAOS will be providing prizes as follows: 1st place \$250, 2nd place \$150 and 3rd place \$50

Judging will be done by a panel of 3 judges including the CIC director or designee, the AAOS president or designee, and Stuart May, Professional Photographer and co-owner of Fusions Art Gallery.

Additionally, the 1st place winner's art will be added to the AAOS inventory of posters and the 2nd and 3rd place winners will have their art placed on a postcard. These items are sold both retail and wholesale by AAOS.
