

Artist of the Month - Gina McCauley

Artists of the month is Mama Snooter, AKA Gina McCauley. Mama Snooter is a very talented fiber artist who creates and makes soft felted-wool sculptures and baskets. Her creations are called Snooter-doots.

Gina has been crafting and making things in one form or another most of her life. She has been working with

wool in various forms for over 17 years. In the past she has made felted hats which she sold at a local farmer's market. She then started making felted vegetables and various critters, now called Snooter-Doots.



Snooter-Doots are created by knitting the body (shell) to shape, then wet-felting it (technically called "fulling"). Once stuffed with fiberfill, the signature wonky eyes are attached by needle-felting. They then get their names, birthdays and often tell Mama Snooter what their hobbies are. Then all of her critters are ready for adoption and their forever families.

Her newest creations are her felted-wool baskets which are hand-knit to shape in nine different color schemes, then wet-felted. Attached to each one is a driftwood handle which is accessorized with shells



collected from Ocean Shore beaches. Each basket is one-ofa-kind, and will add a unique and lovely touch to any décor.



In addition, they make wonderful gifts for both children and adults.



Mama Snooter's art, not only shows off her creativity but a great sense of humor.

If this article has given you the bug for learning felting (both wet and needle styles) and knitting, Gina teaches the art at monthly classes at Beach Tyme Quilts in Ocean Shores.



Flamenco Dancer coming to Aberdeen

June 21, 7:30 p. m.



Savannah Fuentes, Flamenco dancer, and producer, is one of the only touring artists in the Pacific Northwest region with deep connections to Flamenco culture, presenting "... real Flamenco, straight and stunning," (Regina Hackett, Seattle Post Intelligencer.) She has independently produced and danced in over 300 performances and workshops featuring internationally recognized Spanish Flamenco artists, including Carlos de Jacoba, Saray Munoz, and Jesus Montova.

Savannah Fuentes was born in Seattle to parents of Puerto Rican and Irish ancestry. Her fascination with Flamenco dance (baile) and singing (cante) came to her in early childhood, fueled by watching a Flamenco performance on television "...and, although I was just a child, I felt an immediate connection to the art form."

Ms. Fuentes considers Flamenco a lifelong study, an artistic journey she began in her late teens that continues to this day.
She has studied with many notable Flamenco artists including

Guadiana, Joaquin Grilo, Eva Yerbabuena, El Farru, and Isabel Bayon. Ms. Fuentes attributes her formation as an

artist to her most significant mentor,
Maestra Sara de Luis. Accompanied by
her notable guest artists, Savannah
Fuentes tours the West annually, bringing
delighted audiences authentic, passionate Flamenco performance art. She

regularly tours throughout Washington, Oregon, California, Nevada, Utah, Montana, Idaho, Colorado, and Arizona – often performing for communities that would otherwise be unable to enjoy this unique art form.




