## **Images – due Tuesday, September 5**

Please email a high resolution digital image (in .jpg format) of one of your pieces to Sarah Alvarez (see Contacts) or make arrangements for her to photograph your work. The image should be of a piece that you will be exhibiting and is for promotional purposes—the college website, along with the Gala poster, catalog and postcard mailing. Sarah will also need a headshot of you for the website.

## **Bio/Statement & Labeling for Work – due Wednesday, September 20**

Space in the printed catalog is limited, so please try to limit your artist statement and/or bio to 150 words. If you ramble on, you may end up edited; then you lose control of your own words—horrors! Please email (or mail) this information to Valerie Busch at the library (see Contacts below) along with any art labeling information you have at this time. Include title, year completed, dimensions (height x width x depth), medium and price or NFS(not for sale). Some folks tend to work up until the last minute, so simply provide as much labeling information as you can—call the work “untitled” and just provide dimensions if absolutely necessary. Then get the rest of the details to Valerie ASAP.

## **Address List – due Monday, October 9**

Please send a copy of your mailing list (those you’d like notified of this show), preferably in digital format, to Valerie.

## **Hanging/Installation – Mon., Oct. 23 – Wed., Oct. 25, 7:30am – 8:00pm & Thurs., Oct. 26, 7:30am – 6:00pm**

Be ready to hang or install your work during this time. 2-D work should be sturdily framed. Please make arrangements with Valerie so she knows when you will be coming in and if you will need assistance.

## **Artist Reception – Thursday, October 26, 6:30pm – 7:30pm**

This is our chance to get together as a group prior to the big event—to meet, greet, and eat. And, especially, assist Valerie, to proofread label and catalog information and attend to last minute details. Please plan to attend.

Opening Night – Friday, November 3, 6:00pm – 8:30pm

Please plan to arrive by 5:45pm and stay for the entire reception. Assistance with cleanup of refreshments and the like is always welcome. (It's not arduous, can even be fun, and may score you some tasty leftovers!)
